In the concept of cooperation, the 'in service of' dimension seems more present and more pronounced. We put pride and ego aside in favour of the collective. In Bolivia and Sri Lanka, the 2025 harvests have collapsed dramatically — with losses of up to 90% for Brazil nut and coconut. Behind these figures is a human reality: producers left exposed and vulnerable. When producers suffer these losses, they have no other income; the impact is immediate. **Their lives are reduced to mere survival.**

Of course, **every link in our sourcing projects matters.** Retailers and customers also bear the impact of these crop losses. From downstream to upstream, we're all affected. This is why **I believe cooperation is essential.** Like being caught in a storm on a steep cliff edge, cooperation allows everyone to get through this difficult moment. **Cooperation thrives and takes shape through the quality of our relationships.**

When financial indicators collapse, the strength of relationships cushions the impact and helps offset economic shortfalls. After all, we know **that a quality human relationship** is far more rewarding than an Excel pivot table.

Strong, established ties enable us to navigate these challenges and reach new heights together. We leave no one behind. Ignoring producers would be an error. Of course, we could live without coconut or Brazil nut, but that would pave the way to closing many far more problematic doors.

The bond we build creates a climate of trust; or in another words, it reassures us that the other party hasn't "pull the wool over our eyes". Trust is, after all, the foundation of our business partnership.

Finally, cooperation brings another benefit. Even in times of shortage, our producers stay loyal to us and don't chase the highest bidder. Thanks to this loyalty, we are able to keep on delivering you the orders. The idea of cooperation is a strong theme in the survey we ran with our producers, of which you can read the results in this catalogue (see page 8).

Let's cooperate! Cooperating means recognising that we all play a vital part in achieving our shared vision of the world.

Our CSR commitment

Our CSR approach permeates every level of the company, from our producers' orchards to our offices. In France, it builds on our fair-trade commitment and combines a 2030 vision with concrete day-to-day actions.

OUR 2030 VISION

Since our founding, we have worked exclusively with organic producers. But after the CEC (company's conference for climate)* in 2023, we had a wake-up call and realised we must speed up. **One question captures our urgency: how can we feed a constantly growing population without exhausting the planet's resources and while respecting the minimum social standard?** This question has become our compass, and we have set a new course for 2030: to commit to sustainable, plant-based food that is carbon neutral, that fosters biodiversity, respects soils and living systems, provides fair pay for everyone involved, is healthy and balanced, and is a source of care and pleasure.

Our five strategic pillars by 2030:

- Nurture and cultivate our internal collective
- Supporting producers in transitioning to regenerative models
- Build local and international ecosystems of cooperation
- Raise awareness of the food transition
- Make shared values and governance a driver of regeneration



SHAPE THE 2030 ROADMAP FROM WITHIN WITH SEVE

In a cooperative spirit, we launched SEVE (Supporting Equity and Living Together), an internal process that engages the entire team. On a voluntary basis, four working groups — known as «hives» — meet regularly **to design and propose actions that align with our strategic priorities.** Each quarter, at the SEVE forum, these proposals are shared and approved for implementation.

PROMOTE SUSTAINABLE MOBILITY

Alongside the 2030 Roadmap, we ensure our employees' day-to-day experience reflects our philosophy. On the environmental front, several concrete measures have been launched:

- Provision of three electric bicycles for commuting or professional journeys;
- Payment of a €100 bonus, twice a year, to employees who have completed at least 20 return journeys by carpooling, cycling, bus or train (eight recipients in 2025) ;
- Installation of a charging point in the car park to support staff driving electric vehicles.

Hope for our sourcing projects

When political decisions about climate change leave you bewildered, it's easy to throw in the towel. At Agro Sourcing, we choose — at our scale — to trial and innovate to protect living systems and secure our shared future. The results are encouraging.

In Lot-et-Garonne, a south-west region of France, trees are holding strong thanks to regenerative hydrology and agroecology.

In 2024, our partner Amandera's almond and hazelnut trees stood firm while other producers' trees died. Why?

Last year, many orchards in Lot-et-Garonne were hit **by heavy rains that left the soils waterlogged**. Deprived of air and oxygen, the waterlogged roots were suffocated, leading to heavy losses of fruit trees across the region. An **'agricultural disaster'** has been officially recognised by the government to compensate affected farmers.

At Amandera, the trees stood strong. It's the result of meticulous work that combines agroecology and regenerative hydrology. This dual approach **enhances soil structure and infiltration capacity, helping to preserve the balance between water, air and organic matter**. Outcome: despite the heavy rains, Amandera's trees avoided prolonged waterlogging and the orchards were completely spared.

This underlines the importance of investing now in more resilient agricultural approaches.



Turkish vineyards: the benefits of cover crops

In Turkey, introducing cover crops such as vetch or rye is transforming vineyard management. On the same plot, the contrast is striking: without a cover crop, water runs off, soils become compacted and the vine struggles to recover in spring. **With a cover crop, water is absorbed more effectively, the soil breathes and maintains good health.** These winter cover crops improve water infiltration, reduce nutrient leaching, curb weed growth and prevent excessive tillage. Destroyed in spring, they return a valuable nutrient boost – supplying up to three-quarters of the vine's needs. Finally, they help shield the soil from heat and reduce thermal stress. **A virtuous practice that enhances both vine resilience and soil health.**



Almond trees: an innovative biological control against *Eurytoma*

The Spanish almond tree is up against a formidable pest: *Eurytoma amygdali*, a small insect that feeds on almonds. Until now, biological solutions have delivered limited results, fuelling concerns of a slide back to chemical treatments. Together with our producer, we've chosen a different path. Inspired by the vaccine principle, **we've created a natural formulation from forest litter enriched with crushed *Eurytoma* larvae.** We sprayed it across the orchards at the insect's critical life stages. This spray is boosted by complementary solutions such as kaolin and essential oils. Early results are promising: a 40% reduction in infestations on the trees tested. **A promising innovation to protect both orchards and the environment.**

What does it mean to be a BIOPARTENAIRE®?

To be awarded the BIOPARTENAIRE® label, our products must contain at least 50%* of fair trade ingredients from one or more Biopartnerships: chains of reciprocal, sustainable and fair commitments between Biopartners (farmers, processors, manufacturers and distributors).

To be awarded the BIOPARTENAIRE® label, our products must be certified organic in accordance with current European regulations, and comply with the Fair For Life (FFL) guarantee standards for Biopartnerships organised between France and other countries.

The label guarantees that Biopartners sign contracts and respect commitments. And this is true at every stage: from the farm that produces the agricultural raw material, to the company that puts the label on its products.

As a member and administrator of the BIOPARTENAIRE® label and association, our commitments are as follows:

- Organic and Fair Trade are inextricably linked: progressive labelling of all sectors
- Multi-year quantitative commitments
- Producer costs and income guaranteed by minimum prices
- Development aid (social, economic, environmental) through the implementation of fairtrade premiums collected from our customers.

The quality of our products

FEW NUMBERS:

€ 111 000 budget for analysing our dried fruit for pesticides and other contaminants.

1672 analyses carried out by accredited laboratories (pesticide, microbiological, mycotoxin, heavy metal, sulphite and allergen analyses...).

926 Internal analyses: moisture analyses, Aw (water activity), microbiology analyses for *Bacillus cereus*, *E. coli*, *coliform bacteria*, *Listeria*, *Salmonella*, *yeast*, *mould* and *enterobacteria*.

3 full-time employees in the Quality department.

650 is the average number of molecules included in our pesticide screenings.

450 samples are taken each year for our quality controls.

100 is the number of sensory analyses carried out in-house on raw materials and finished products in our production workshop. Every day, we test our dried fruits to ensure the quality of their taste, their texture...

All this Quality Control work enables us to define our action plan for the following year: identification of priority sectors, investments values to be allocated, type of interventions to be planned, training programs...

It is thanks to this daily work carried out over the past 20 years that we are now able to guarantee high-quality dried fruit, both in terms of sensory quality and food safety.

*So what is an isotope?

It is a variant of a chemical element that is found in specific quantities in different geological layers in the region's mountain ranges. The best known is Carbon 14 (as opposed to Carbon 12, which is the stable form), which is used for geological dating. These isotopes are also found in plants and fruit that have grown in the region, and by analysing the strontium in nuts we can determine whether they have indeed grown in the declared region of origin.

AUTHENTICATED GEOGRAPHICAL ORIGIN

An isotopic analysis carried out by a trusted third party (external laboratories) enables us to confirm the origin of the nuts (certificate of authentication of geographical origin). **We have therefore worked on an analysis methodology that makes it possible to authenticate the geographical area of production by quantifying isotopes*.**

We can now identify the geographical origin of a cashew nut (Africa or Vietnam)... **After all, if there is fraud in terms of origin, there is potentially fraud at the organic level because there is clearly fraud in terms of traceability...**

Apricots from the Malatya plateaus in Turkey

Our oldest supply chain, in the south of Turkey, in the arid plateaux around Malatya, gave its name to this variety of apricot. The **350 producers** we support as part of our **Organic and Fair Trade** program harvest these apricots, selected for their aromatic richness and supple texture after drying : **brown apricots**, simply sun-dried, with a sweet, caramelised flavour, and **soft apricots**, slightly rehydrated for a creamy texture, with more complex flavours.






